I am requesting Community Project Funding for the Merrymount Parkway Bridge Replacement, Quincy, Norfolk County, MA, 8th District in fiscal year 2025. Lastly, by enhancing infrastructure and improving connectivity, this initiative aims to attract new businesses, stimulate private investment, create job opportunities, and facilitate access to local amenities, recreational areas, and cultural attractions, further enhancing the quality of life for residents.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 23 U.S.C.133(b).
